### Family Child Care Stabilization Grant

# Why?

- Provides funding for costs you are already going to have that are COVID-related: PPE, cleaning supplies, and others.
- Gets you \$2,500 in cash when you provide documentation

### How?

- \*Apply through Programs for Parents
- Apply first to get part of the \$2,500.
- \*Then collect receipts and documentation for final payment.



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### Child & Adult Food Program

# Why?

- \* Food provided in care can be critical for a child's development.
- Provides up to \$0.96 per child for snacks and up to \$3.51 for meals.
- Open to for-profit and nonprofits.
- Can be for new or existing food services.



### Child & Adult Food Program

### How?

- \* Apply through Programs for Parents.
- \* Requires some training and paperwork.

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#### CHILD AND ADULT CARE FOOD PROGRAM **FAMILY DAY CARE ENROLLMENT FORM**

Your day care Provider participates in the Child and Adult Care Food Program. This program extends the benefits of the National School Lunch Program to children in Family Day Care Homes. Because your Provider cares about good nutrition, s/he has chosen the benefits of the Child and Adult Care Food Program for their Family Day Care home.

Under the regulations of the Child and Adult Care Food Program, your Provider may not charge for the meals served and claimed for reimbursement. In addition, the Provider may not ask you to supply food for your child to claim for reimbursement under CACFP. Day care fees charged by your Provider cover the care of your child and other food costs not claimed for reimbursed under the Child and Adult Care Food Program.

A diet statement from your doctor is needed if your child is unable to consume food components required by the Child and Adult Care Food Program. The statement allows your child to participate in the Child and Adult Care Food Program and maintain the diet prescribed by your doctor.

### NJ PPE Access Program

# Why?

- Provides a 10% discount on PPE.
- Available to for-profits and nonprofits- any small business in New Jersey.



### NJ PPE Access Program

### How?

- Start with the state web site: ppe.covid19.nj.gov
- \*Then register with approved vendors.

# Tips & Tricks

- PPE is the cost category with the greatest increase in COVID and the most variable Most providers are spending even more than they realize.
- Get in as soon as you can, already had one "additional 25%" day.
- Can pair with the Stabilization Grant.



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# School-aged Child Subsidy

# Why?

- Existing child care subsidy program now extends to full day care for school-aged children in households making \$150,000 or less.
- 'Includes registered and licensed care providers.
- Ends December 30, 2020.



### School-aged Child Subsidy

#### How?

- If a parent is already approved or eligible for after school or summer camp they should contact Programs for Parents.
- Other parents should apply through the state: www.childcarenj.gov/COVID-19-School-Age-Tuition-Assistance-Application
- Providers don't need to do anything differently to accept the funds.



#### COVID-19 Child Care

With the school year starting in New Jersey amid the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the state announced plans to dedicate \$250 million in funding from the federal Coronavirus Relief Fund, which will provide additional support to children and their families as well as for thousands of child care providers with resources.

#### School-Age Tuition Assistance Program

The New Jersey School-Age Tuition Assistance Program can help you pay for care for your school-age child in need of child care as a result of COVID-19 remote learning schools schedules. To be eligible for this assistance, you must be:

- a NJ resident;
- your child must be attending school remotely, either part-time or full-time; and
- your annual gross household income must be \$150,000 or less.

Note, the income cap was increased from \$75,000 to \$150,000 on October 1. If you previously applied for tuition assistance and were denied because of income, someone will be reaching out to you shortly.

#### Tuition rates are:

Provider Type	Full-Time Monthly Rate	Part-Time Monthly Rate
Licensed Child Care Centers	\$634.27	\$317.14
Registered Family Child Care	\$526.52	\$263.26

This assistance is available until December 30, 2020 and applications will be accepted until funds are exhausted.

### Families First Coronavirus Leave

# Why?

- \*Receive up to 10 days of full pay (up to \$511 a day) for you or your employees (w-2 only) for COVID illness, caring for family member, or quarantine.
- \* Receive up to 12 weeks of 2/3 pay (up to \$200 a day) for care for your child at home because of a school closure (including remote school).
- Can be used part-time.



### Families First Coronavirus Leave

#### **How? For Sole Proprietors**

- Keep track of the time and reason on a spreadsheet or document. Note if it is medial leave (paid at full rate) or taking care of a child (paid at 2/3 rate).
- Deduct the amount from your quarterly estimated taxes.
- Ensure you report it on your 2020 tax return (will include any additional funds).

#### **How? For Corporations**

- Use the form 7200 to request the tax credit.
- Checks usually arrive within a few weeks of submission.

A key component of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA) is paid family leave for small business employees that is reimbursed for employers.

#### Is my business eligible?

If you have fewer than 500 employees, you can take advantage of the FFCRA. Even if you are a sole proprietor or self-employed and it is just you — you can take advantage of the program.

#### How does it work?

The FFCRA covers leave taken between April 1, 2020 and December 30, 2020. There are two types of leave available.

First, Emergency Paid Sick Leave Act (EPSLA) provides up to 80 hours of sick leave for employees:

- At their regular rate of pay (up to \$511 per day with a cap of \$5,110 for the whole 80 hours) if the employee is quarantined for potential COVID-19 exposure or has COVID-19 symptoms.
- At two-thirds their regular rate of pay (up to \$200 per day with a cap of \$2,000) if the employee is caring for someone under quarantine or a child (under 18) whose school is closed due to COVID-19 or the employee is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and seeking diagnosis. A school closure includes remote learning situations where the child is at home.

Second, The Emergency Family and Medical Leave Expansion Act (EFMLEA) provides up to 12 weeks of expanded family and medical leave with 10 of those weeks paid at two-thirds the employee's regular rate of pay (up to \$200 per day with a cap of \$2,000) if the employee is unable to work (including telework) to care for a child whose school or childcare provider is closed due to COVID-19. A school closure includes remote learning situations where the child is at home.

**NOTE:** You can use your EPSLA or your existing leave to cover the first two unpaid weeks of EFMLEA. Also, leave can be taken intermittently. For example, a parent could take off every Thursday and Friday.

#### How do I get reimbursed?

You get reimbursed through a "refundable tax credit." That's a technical way of saying the United States Treasury pays you using money from employment taxes. Think of this term as simply a "reimbursement" for the applicable wages.

Reimbursement is handled differently if the employee taking the leave is a "W-2 employee" or a sole proprietor/self-employed individual.

**NOTE:** A person working with you who is an independent contractor (they receive a 1099 from you) cannot be reimbursed through your company, but can apply directly.

#### For W-2 Employees:

You can get reimbursement for W-2 employees in two ways.

- First, you can take the money owed off your quarterly employment tax returns (this is typically through an IRS form 941). Any credit above what you are paying in federal employment tax can be requested using the IRS From 7200.
- Second, you can request payment any time (even more than once in a quarter) using the <u>IRS Form 7200</u> (even if you didn't withhold your payroll taxes). The <u>Form 7200</u> is easy, and since it can be done as many times as you want, it's an easier way to ensure a positive cash flow for your business.

#### For Sole Proprietors & the Self-Employed:

You can get reimbursed by withholding the money equal to the leave (per the limits above) from your quarterly estimated tax payments or by claiming it at the end of the year when you do your annual tax filing.

#### What else should I know?

Employers may exclude healthcare providers or emergency responders from EPSLA and EFMLEA leave, and businesses with less than 50 employees can qualify for an exemption if the leave would jeopardize the viability of the business.
